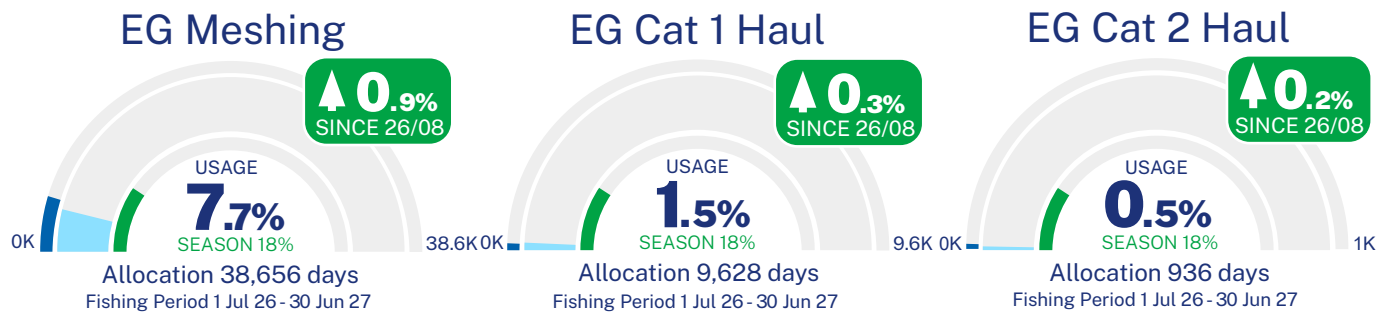

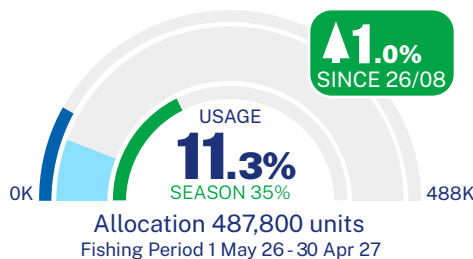

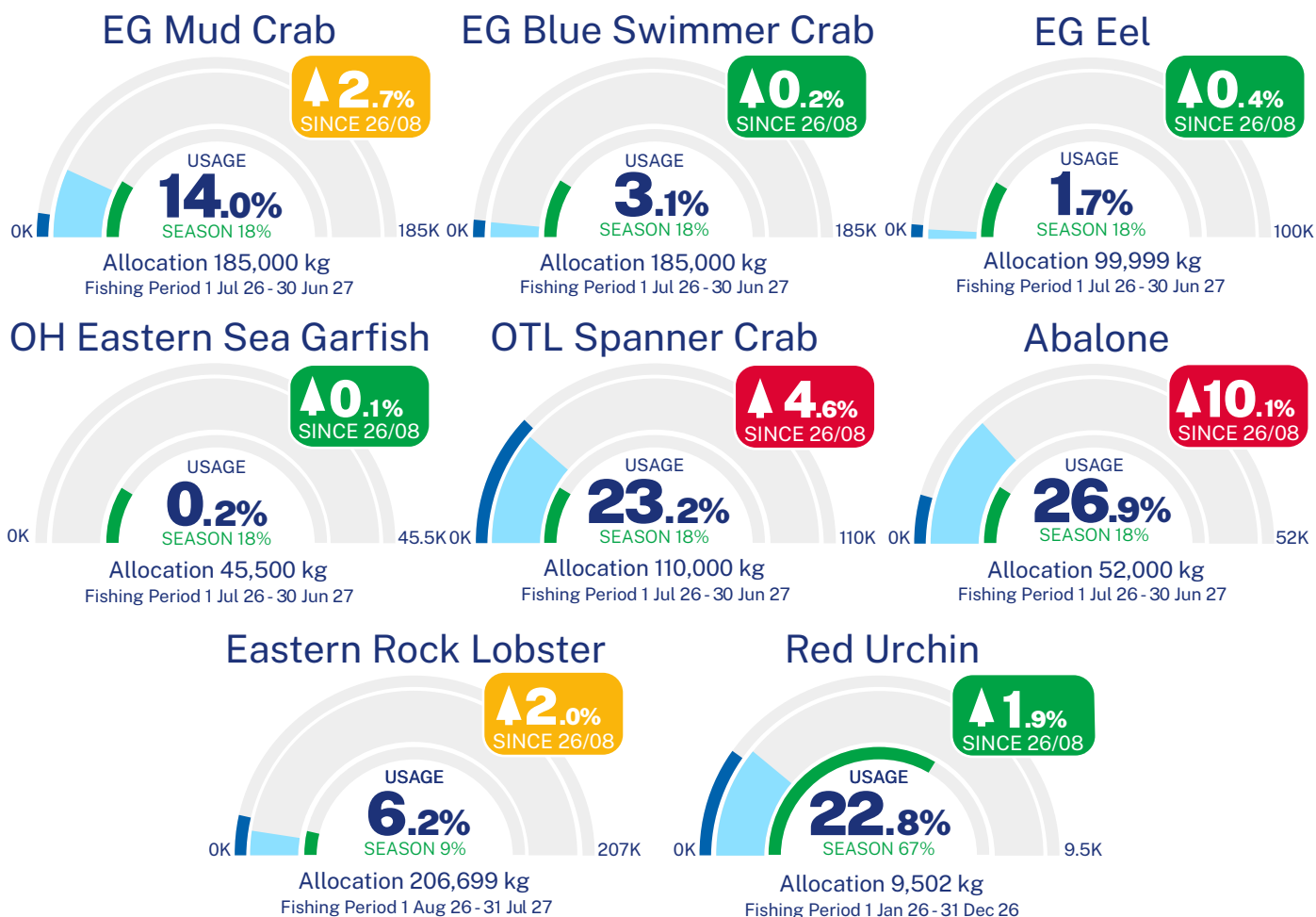
EFFORT QUOTAS @ 4 September 2026



OT Prawn Effort



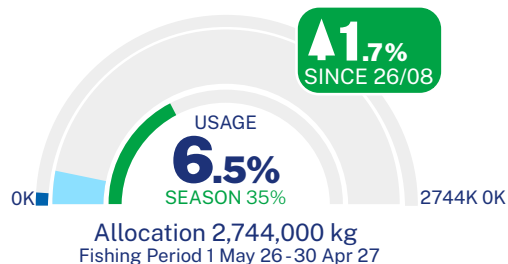
SPECIES QUOTAS @ 4 September 2026



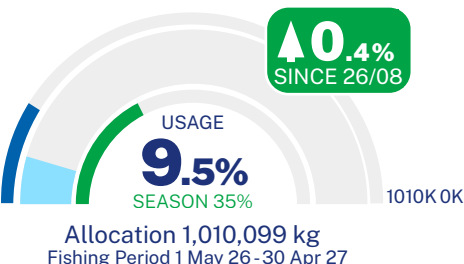

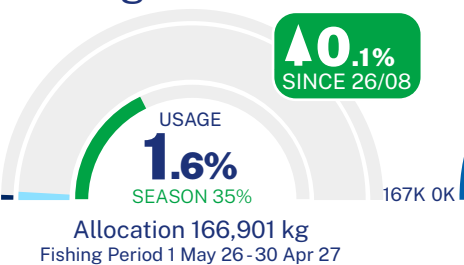

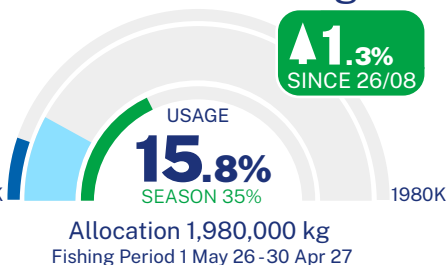

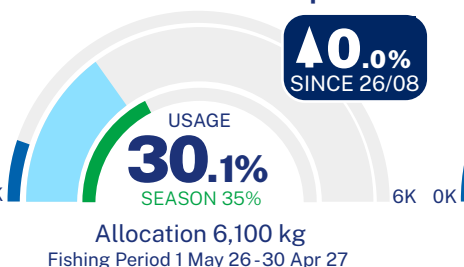

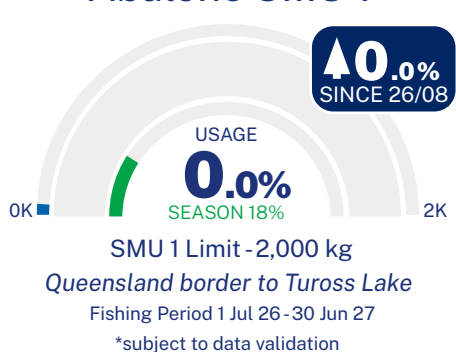

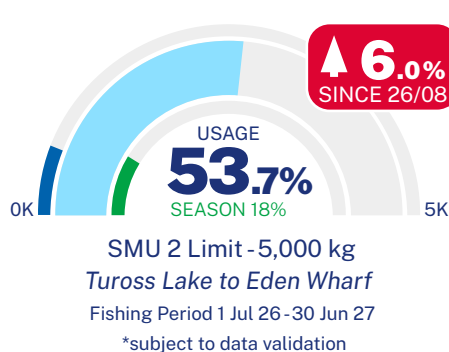


ABALONE SPATIAL CATCH LIMITS @ 4 September 2026

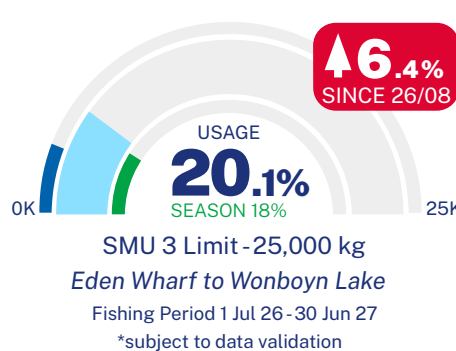
Abalone SMU 1



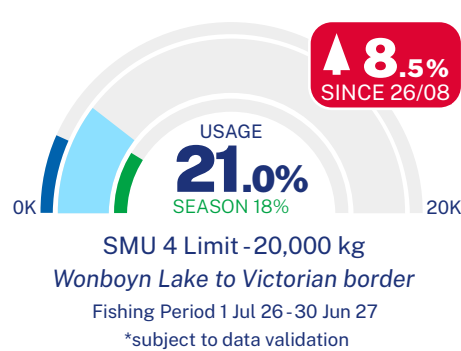
Abalone SMU 2

CALCULATING CATCH AND EFFORT QUOTA

Important information

- Each Total Allowable Catch (TAC) and Total Allowable Effort (TAE) determination in a share management fishery is allocated among shareholders as quota to each fishing business proportional to the number of relevant shares held.
- The TAC determination for Red Sea Urchin is allocated equally as quota to each fishing business in the Sea Urchin and Turban Shell fishery holding a Sea Urchin endorsement.
- Each allocation is made rounded to one decimal place. The allocation figures shown in this table are an approximation per share and rounded to two decimal places.
- Quota is allocated before the start of each fishing period, and the quota may be used or transferred within that period.
- The amount of quota allocated will change if a new TAC/TAE is determined, shares or endorsements are removed from the system (i.e., cancelled, following forfeiture or surrender) before the allocation is made, or quota is forfeited at the time a new determination is made.
- Quota for Beachworm and Ghost Nipper is allocated as numbers rather than weight, using a conversion of 1 Beachworm = 10 grams and 1 Ghost Nipper = 3 grams for respective allocations.
